

# Reds

## Merlot

### **Red Rock - \$7/Glass & \$22/Bottle**

Californian wine full of lush concentrations of black plum and boysenberry that are complemented by soft, rounded tannins. The body and flavor are perfectly matched, exquisitely balanced, achieving a delicate harmony found only in the finest wines.

### **Smoking Loon - \$6/Glass & \$18/Bottle**

A wine to charm the senses, the wine beckons with black plum, violets and smoky pipe tobacco aromas in the nose. Rich textural qualities are intertwined with sweet cherry and graham cracker flavors, transporting you back to a childhood dream.

## Shiraz

### **Twin Beaks – \$8/Glass \$24/Bottle**

This classic Australian shiraz is full bodied and rich with a soft palate. It has spicy notes with scents of vanilla. Full-bodied, rich with a soft palate and abundant blueberry flavors and a silky finish.

## Pinot Noir

### **Aquinas - \$8/Glass & \$24/Bottle**

Lots of raspberry and cherry on the nose with notes of cinnamon and damp soil adding a touch of mystery. Medium-bodied with flavors of strawberries framed by silky tannins; a bitter cherry flavor on the finish makes it interesting.

### **Mirassou – \$7/Glass & \$21/Bottle**

The 2006 Mirassou California Pinot Noir displays intense flavors of strawberries, pomegranates, and cherries. These primary flavors are enhanced by secondary flavors of floral and spice characters.

### **Undone - \$8/Glass \$28/Bottle**

The 2007 Undone Pinot Noir is very smooth, with berry and plum notes on the palate. It was fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks, so it has no oak influence – the pure flavors of Pinot Noir show through.

### **Queen of Hearts – \$9/Glass & \$28/Bottle**

A Californian wine that boast a light body but big, juicy dark fruit like black cherries. Pairs well with pizza and pasta with marinara sauces, calzones or a Pork Tenderloin sandwich.

## **Cabernet Sauvignon**

### **The Show - \$9/Glass & \$28/Bottle**

A full-bodied, fruit-forward wine with flavors of dried black cherries and dark fruit compote, the wine is boosted by hints of spice and oaken vanilla. Merlot adds softness while the cabernet franc contributes hints of earth and mouth-watering acidity

### **Rush '05 - \$7/Glass & \$22/Bottle**

The third bottling of the Rush cabernet sauvignon is a blend of 95% cabernet sauvignon from Mendocino County, 4% syrah from the Sonoma Coast, and 1% malbec. The wine, parts of which were sourced from organically farmed vineyards, exhibits a more substantial tannic structure than the first two releases. Copious notes of bright cherry fruit dominate the medium-bodied palate. Only 1117 cases of this limited-production wine were made.

## **Chianti**

### **Luccio '03 - \$6/Glass & \$19/Bottle**

Intense ruby color with aromas of vanilla and spice. This wine features rounded tannins and is best-enjoyed young. This wine compliments grilled meats, pizza and pasta dishes.

## **Red Zinfandel**

### **Rancho Zabaco - Dancing Bull - \$8/Glass & \$24/Bottle**

The wine is immediately approachable with lots of ripe dark fruit flavors of blackberry and black cherry complemented by bright red fruit flavors of raspberry and strawberry. Spicy notes of black pepper and vanilla add layers which allow the fruits to be the star.

## **Malbecs**

### **Parados \$8/Glass & \$24/Bottle**

This light and dry Argentinean wine possesses a lush berry flavor. Delicious with hearty foods like pizza, beef, pastas or a Cuban sandwich.

# **Whites**

## **Chardonnay**

### **Fat Bastard - \$8/Glass & \$24/Bottle**

To craft the Fat bastard Chardonnay, grapes are sourced from all over the Languedoc-Rousillon, from the banks of the Rhone in the east to Carcassonne in the west, and from the foothills of the Massif Central in the north to the Mediterranean coast in the south.

These different origins give the wine the balanced fruit flavor and acidity that have made it a consumer favorite.

### **Rush '06 - \$7/Glass & \$22/Bottle**

The second bottling of this Burgundian-style wine was sourced from a single vineyard in the Suisun Valley, on the eastern edge of the Napa Valley. In order to showcase the character of the chardonnay grape, winemaker Spencer Graham opted to ferment the juice in stainless steel tanks instead of in barrels, which can overpower some of the variety's finer nuances. The wine was cold-fermented and put through malolactic fermentation to bring its natural acidity into balance. To add to the flavor complexity and create roundness on the palate, the wine was left sur lies for four months. The resulting wine reveals vibrant floral and citrus notes, light minerality, and a dry, crisp finish. Distributed exclusively in the state of Alabama, only 1100 cases of this limited-production wine were made.

### **Canyon Road - \$6/Glass & \$18/Bottle**

Medium-bodied wine with notes of crisp apple and ripe citrus fruit with a hint of cinnamon spice. Delicious complement to grilled chicken, lighter pasta dishes or mild cheeses.

### **Pinot Grigio**

#### **Ecco Domani - \$6/Glass & \$18/Bottle**

This wine has a clear, straw yellow color, with light golden reflections. A low concentration of Surmaturato grapes gives the wine tropical fruit notes that make the vintage truly unique. The wine possesses pleasant floral and tropical fruit aromas, and has a light, crisp, clean and refreshing flavor, with fruit character and refined elegance.

#### **Maso Canali - \$9/Glass & \$28/Bottle**

Maso Canali 2007 Pinot Grigio has a brilliant pale golden color and a full, ripe palate. The nose delivers peach and a hint of honey, and the wine is characterized by enticing flavors of lemon and fresh apple, with floral notes. It is well-balanced with a lovely, persistent finish and a lively acidity.

#### **Klostor - \$8/Glass & \$24/Bottle**

Pinot grigio never tasted so good! The Klostor Wine pinot grigio from Mosel-Saar-Ruwer is light and bright with concentrated flavors of grapefruit, juicy apples and a hint of mineral. If you are looking for a delicious and refreshing wine treat, this pinot grigio from Germany offers a wine with a fantastic finish.

## **Riesling**

### **Pepperwood Grove - \$6/Glass & \$18/Bottle**

Golden straw in color, Pepperwood Grove's Australian Riesling has aromas of apricots, hibiscus blossom, and hint of sweet lavender. With integrated sweetness, the flavors of pineapple, nectarine, candied ginger, and subtle lemongrass and blood orange notes are profound yet delicate.

## **Sauvignon Blanc**

### **Whitehaven - \$9/Glass & \$28/Bottle**

Whitehaven Sauvignon Blanc 2004 is a full flavored medium bodied wine, with an abundance of currant and gooseberry flavors, and a clean, lingering finish. A light straw-colored wine with lemon-lime tones, vibrant currant-leaf and gooseberry aromas, some pungent herbaceous nuances, and a hint of ripe citrus.

### **Screw Kappa Nappa - \$8/Glass & \$24/Bottle**

This Sauvignon Blanc has aromas of coconut and jasmine. Upront apricot notes are rounded out with a vanilla creme brulee and butterscotch palate.

## **Gruener Veltliner**

### **Berger \$9/Glass & \$28/Bottle**

A Super-Organic Austrian white wine that is amazingly refreshing and crisp. Goes well with salads, pastas, pesto dishes, vegetarian dishes and Chicken salad.
